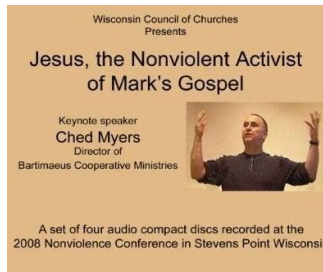

“Jesus, the Nonviolent Activist of Mark’s Gospel,” featuring four lectures delivered by Ched Myers, Director of Bartimaeus Cooperative Ministries, at a nonviolence conference in Stevens Point, Wisconsin, in November 2008.
