



Teaching the Truth about School Board Takeovers

Banning books, micromanaging curricula, restricting pronoun preference and what teachers can display in their classrooms - there is a trend nationwide, and particularly in Milwaukee-area suburbs, of school boards being taken over by GOP-endorsed members. This is a planned agenda, promoted by several very well-funded and organized, right-wing extremist groups. *It's time to realize what is happening locally to better understand how to counter this offensive.*
